
Canegrub identification: Northern Region

Anal hair (raster) patterns of canegrubs found in the Tully to Mossman region:




1. Greyback

Two almost straight rows of 20-28 short hairs.



2. Grisea

Two straight rows of 26-34 short thick hairs.




3. Grata

Two slightly curved rows of 18-26 thick hairs, hairs in each row close together compared with greyback.



4. Rothe's

Two slightly curved rows of 10-12 elongate hairs.



5. Froggatt's

Two single rows plus partial rows at rear, of 12-23 stout hairs.




6. Caudata

Pear-shaped, 22-44 long hairs each side.




7. Consobrina

Pear-shaped and continuing forward as single lines of 5-8 hairs, about 50 long hairs each side.



8. French's

Pear-shaped, about 50 long hairs each side.



9. Sororia

Almost circular, about 45 long hairs each side.
